

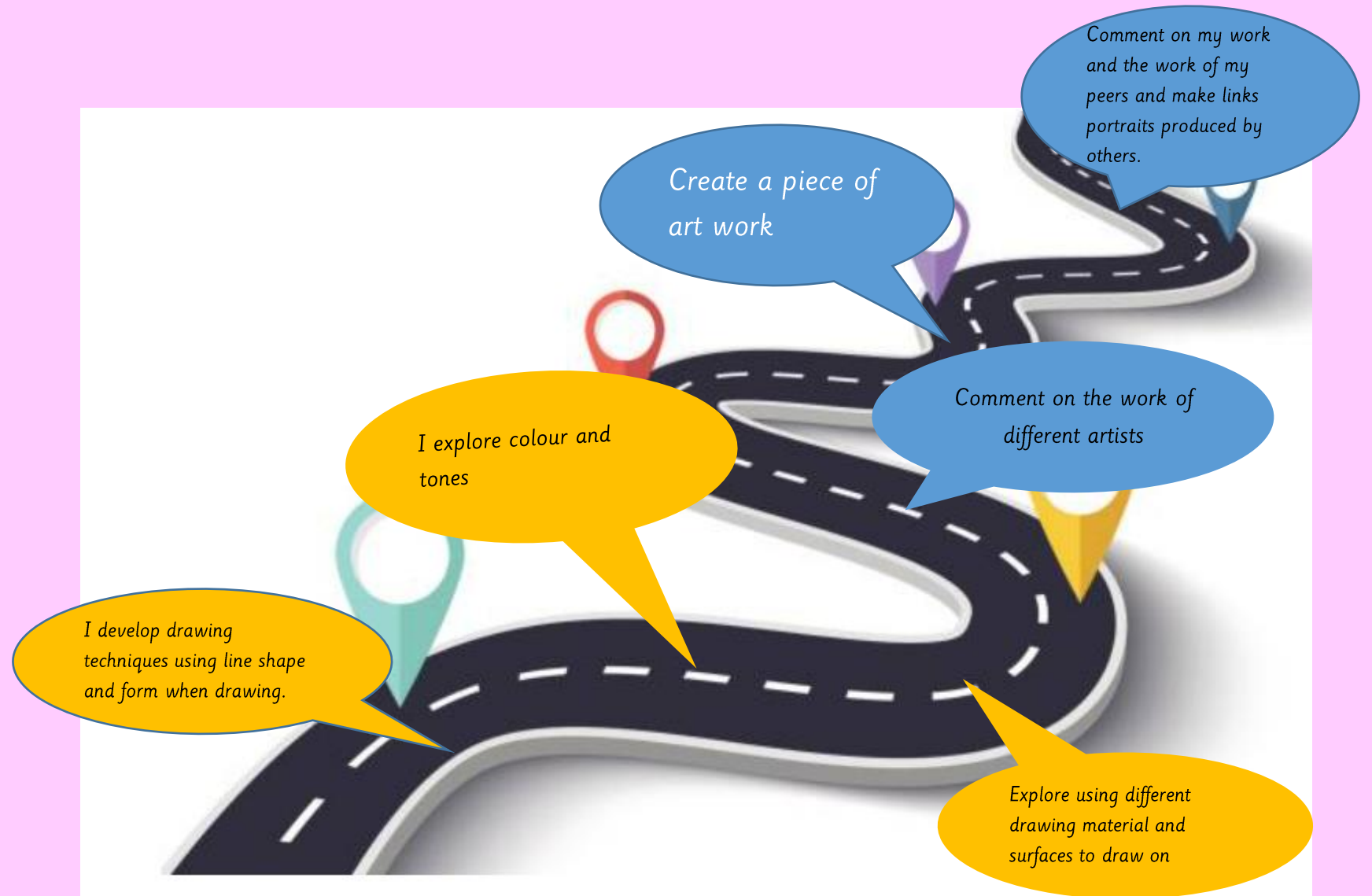

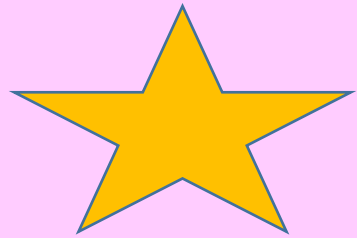
Steps to success



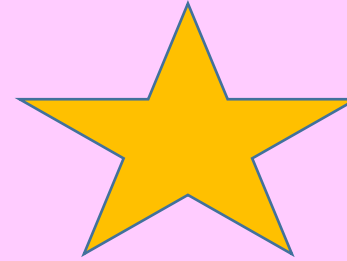
All – I can draw from a different angle

Some – I can add texture and lines to create shapes.



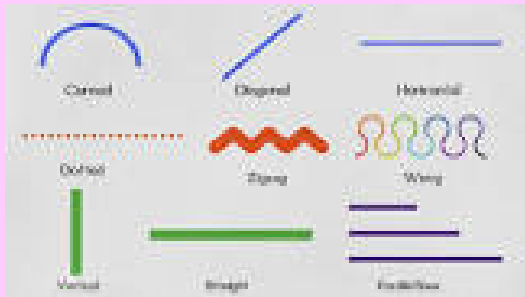

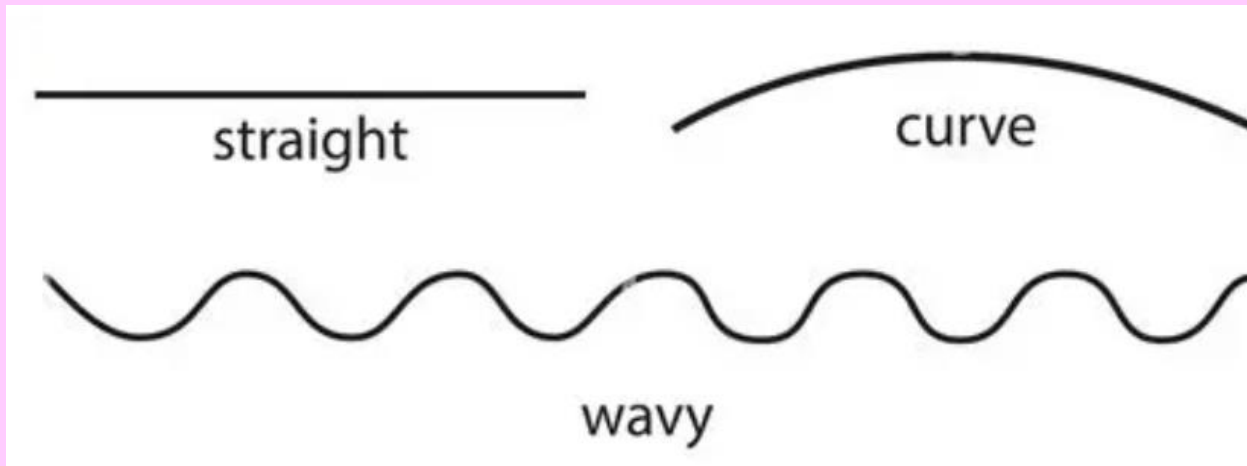

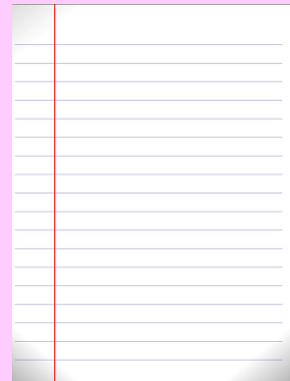

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We can also draw from different angles.

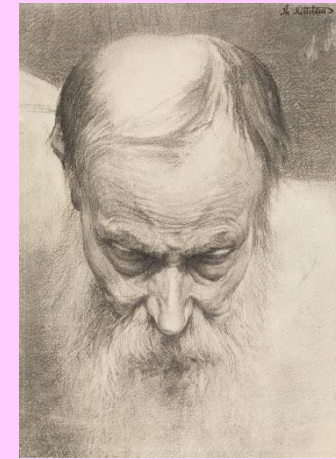
TP: What different angles can we draw from?

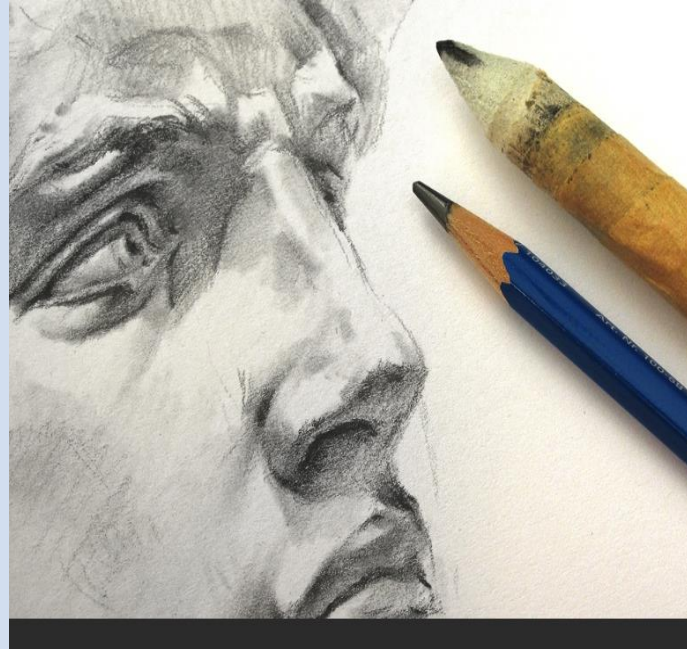
