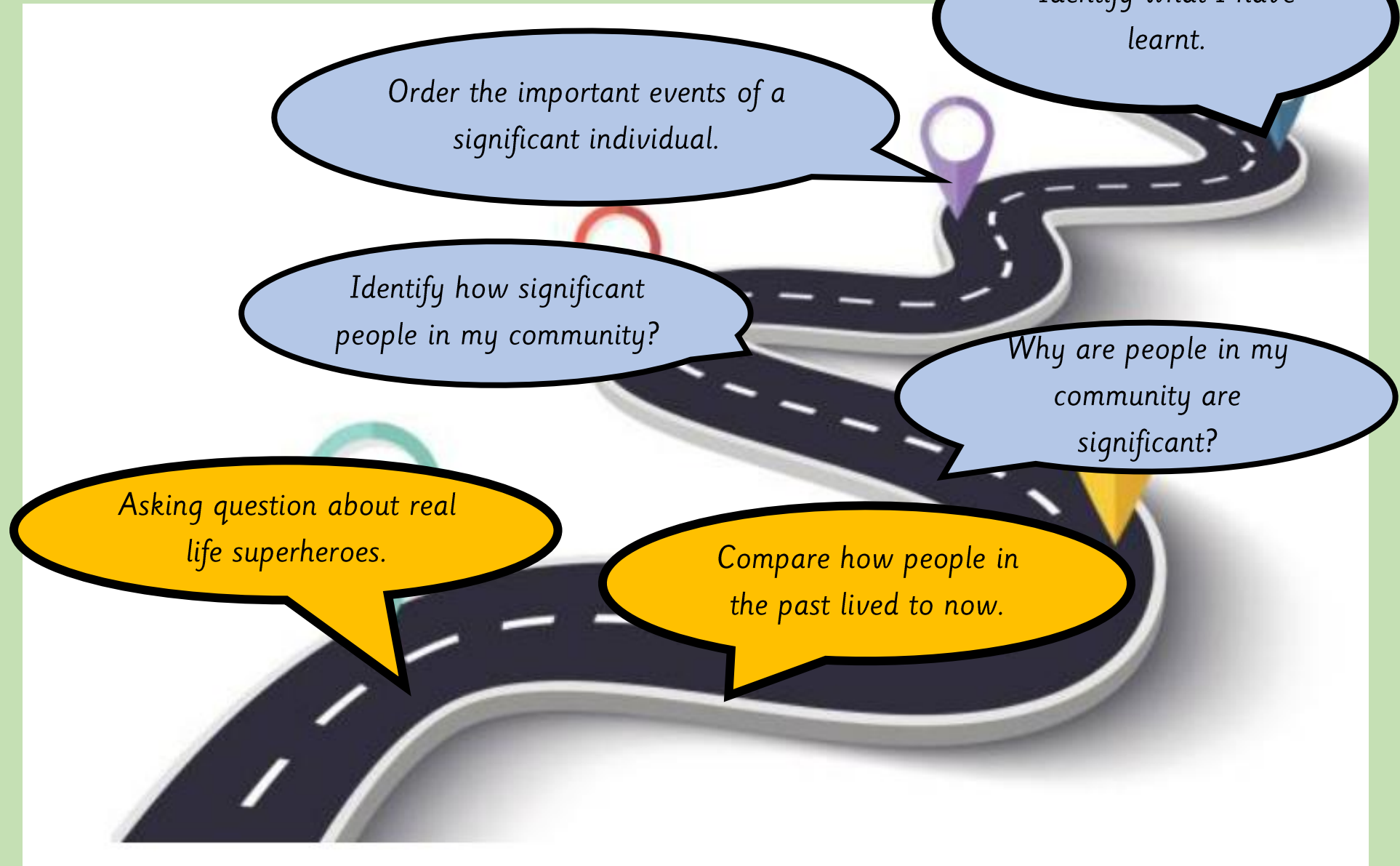

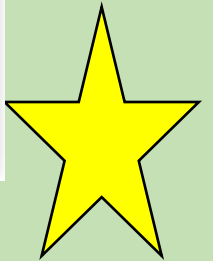

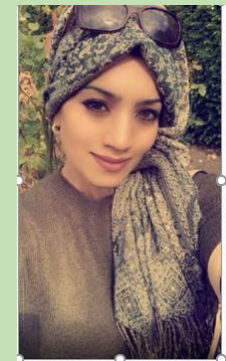

How have healthcare workers changed from the past to present?



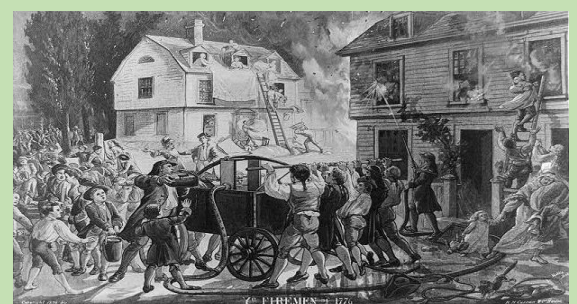
