Assumptions



A **stereotype** is an idea (assumption) or image that many people have about a group. It can be thought of as a '**label**'. These labels can be about how people act, what they like, how they look, or what they can do.



Look at these pictures.

Some people have **assumptions** (ideas) about boys and girls and what they should or should not do.



Some people expect boys and girls to behave in certain ways. It is ok to be yourself. This is known as being *different*.



Some people get **bullied** for being different.

TPs: What is bullying?



Bullying is a type of **unkind behaviour**, such as being mean to others on purpose. Sometimes people who bully others may be feeling sad or angry and might take their negative feelings out on others.
