Baby

A teenager is between 13-19 years old. The body goes through a lot of changes at this age. Voice, hair and facial features will start to change. Teenagers start to get moody as their body goes through certain changes. Teenagers will grow even taller and perhaps wider.

Adult



Adult

When you become an adult your facial features and your body will have changed even further. Your skin will change, you will start to have more wrinkles. You will have more responsibilities such as caring for your own family and home. Adults will usually have to go out to work. Adults will notice changes to their hair such as thinning or becoming grey. You stop growing taller when you are an adult and sometimes you may become forgetful. Some adults get more tired quickly and often. They may not be as fit and healthy as they were when they were younger.

Elderly

Elderly people become slower and weaker than when they were younger. Their skin gets more wrinkly and their bones will get more fragile. Their hair will start to turn white or grey. Some may even start to loose their hair. Elderly people may start to get shorter, and they may need a walking stick to help them move around. The hearing and eye sight of some elderly people will not be as good as when they were younger. Some elderly people may also become deaf.
