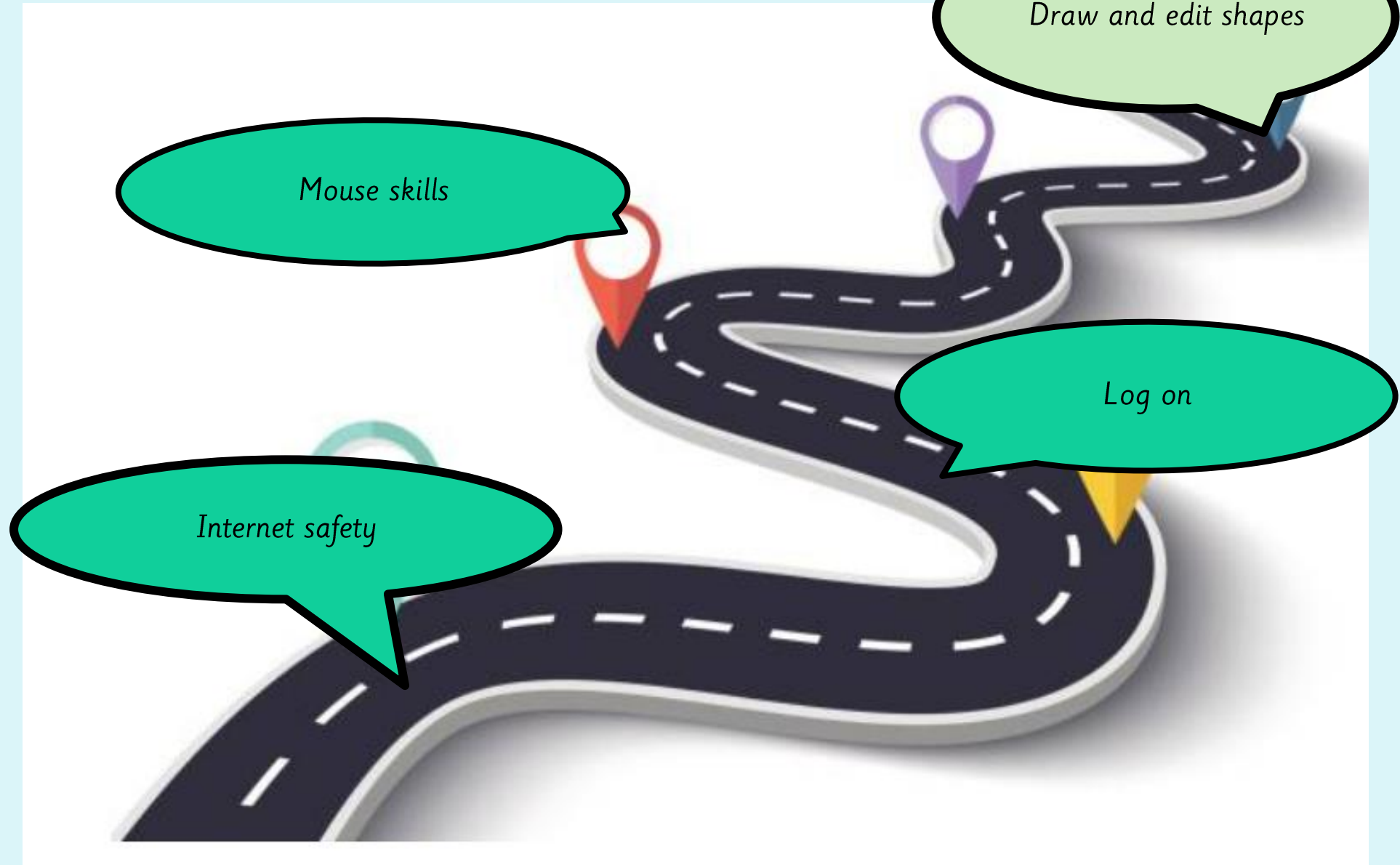

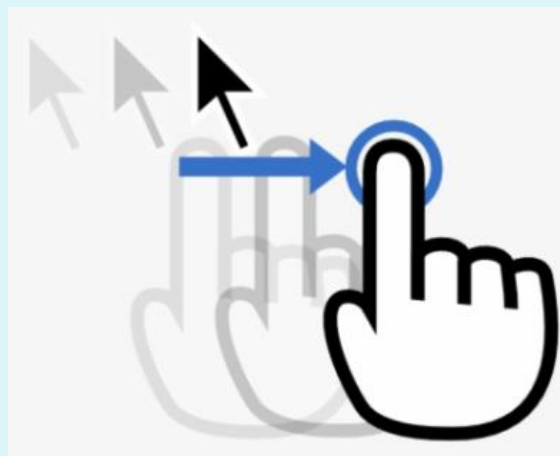

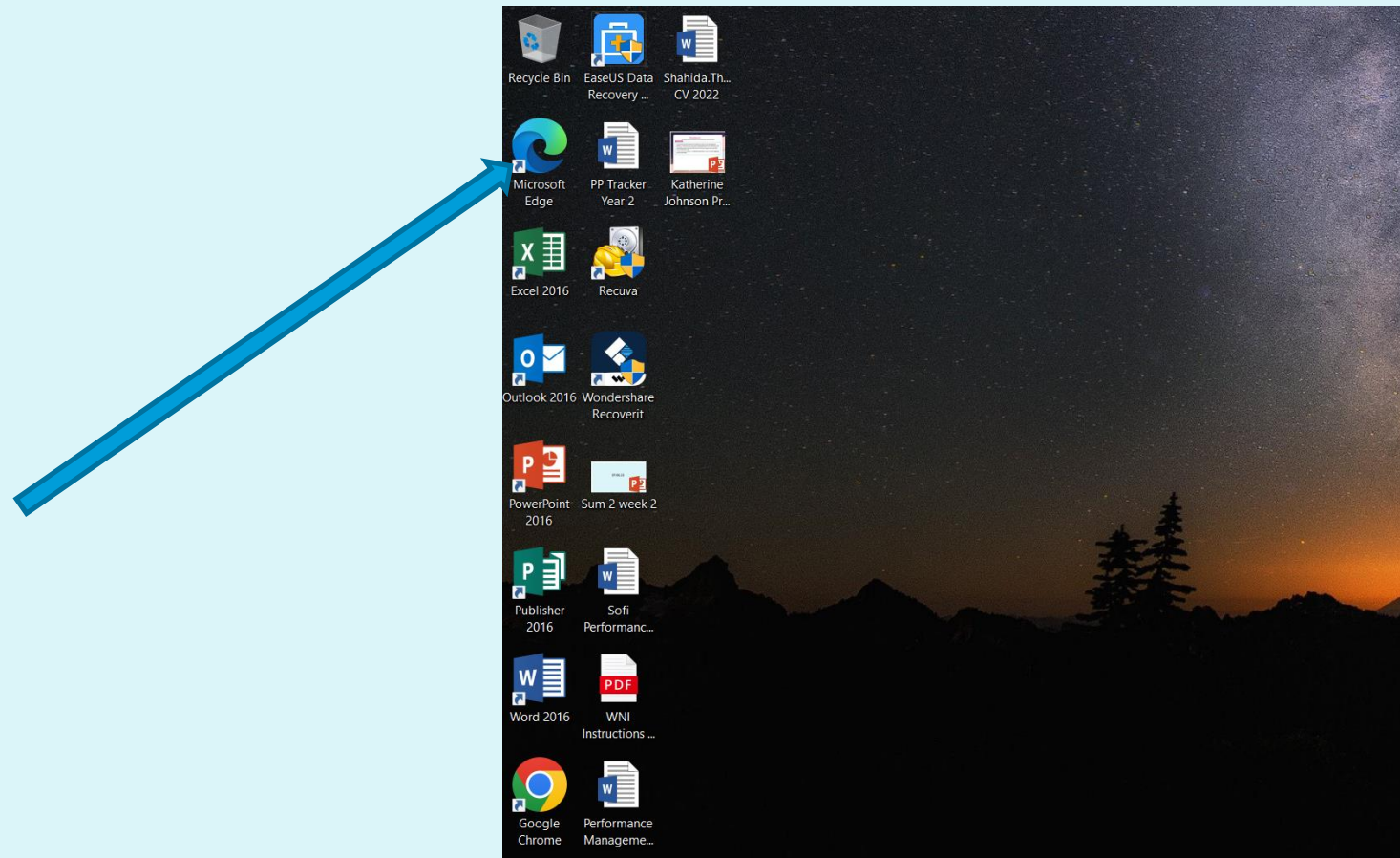
Today you are going to use a online art tool called Sketchpad

Using Sketchpad

Using Sketchpad, we will:

1. Create a simple **background**.
2. Stamp clipart over the top to create a **repeated** image.



Creating a background



Vector Fill

To change the background colour:

1. Click on the **Fill** icon.

Creating a background



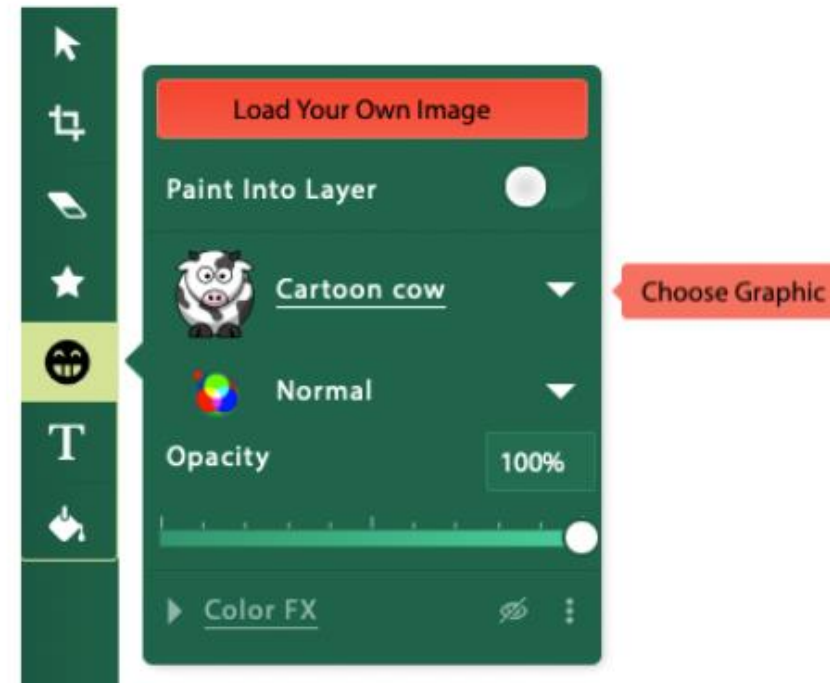
2. Click on the **Fill box**.
3. Select a colour.
4. Click on the background to change it.

Let's go through the steps to create repetitive images.

Adding Clipart stamps

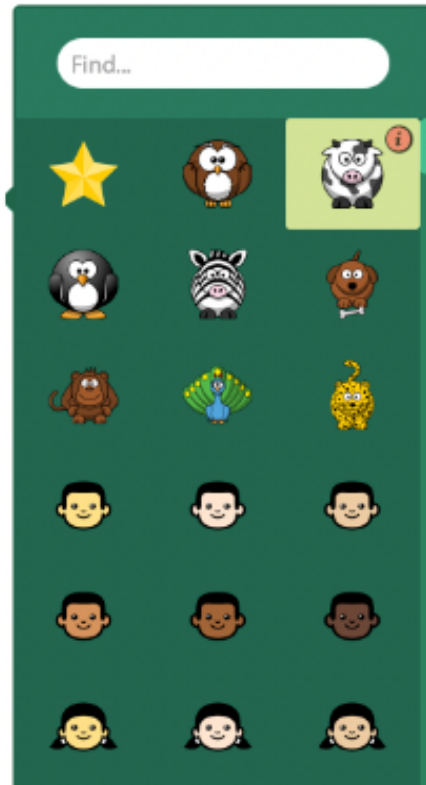


1. Click on the smiley face.

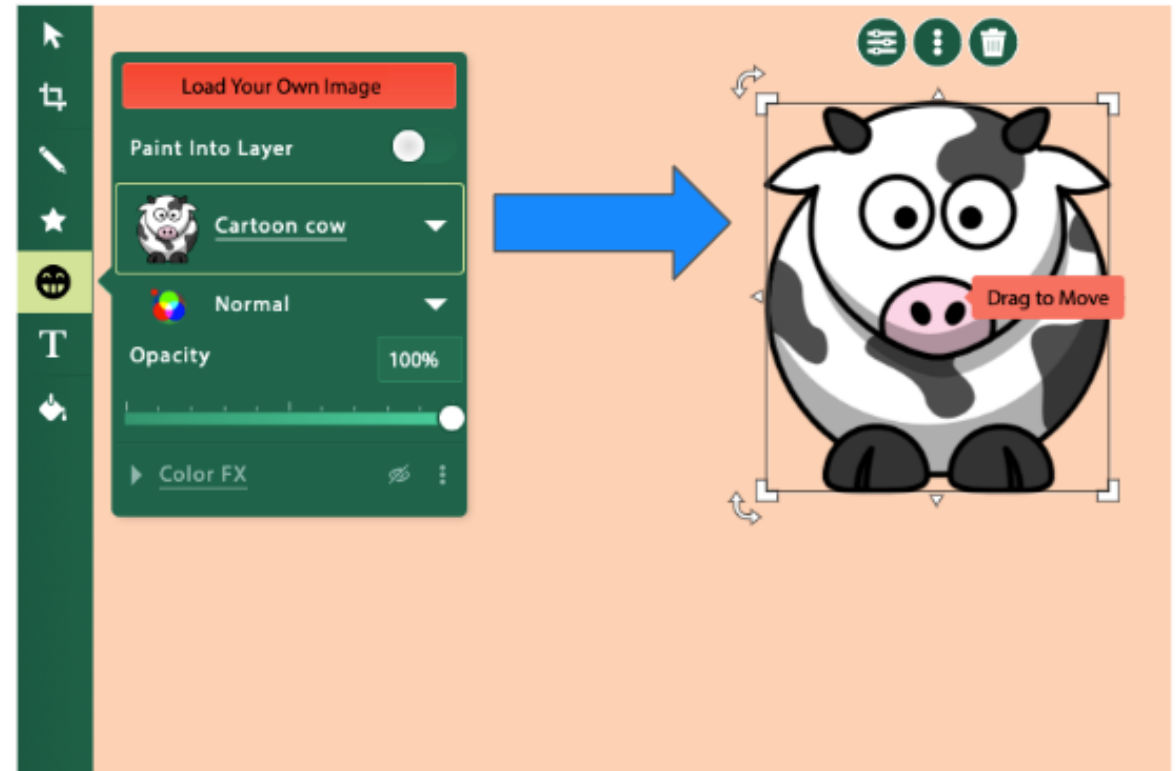


2. Click on the down arrow to Choose Graphic.

Adding Clipart stamps

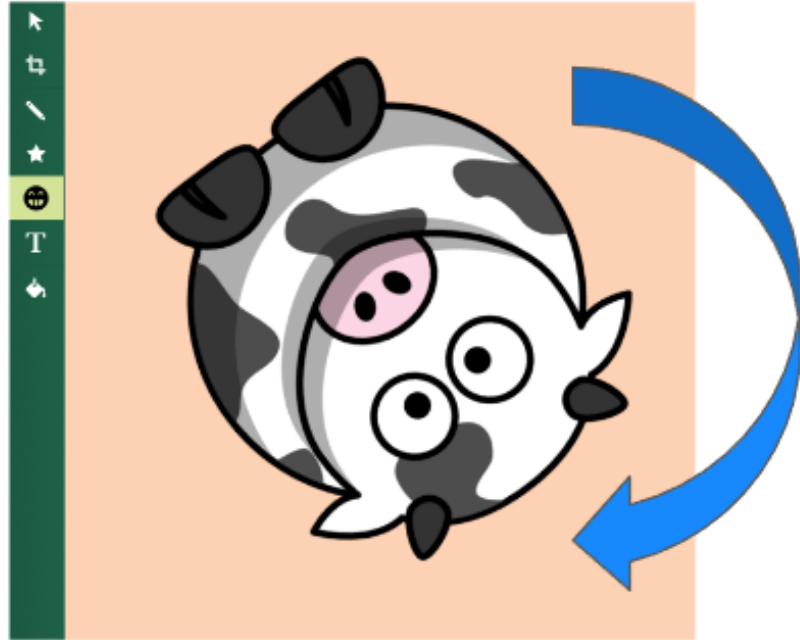


3. Select a **clipart** image.

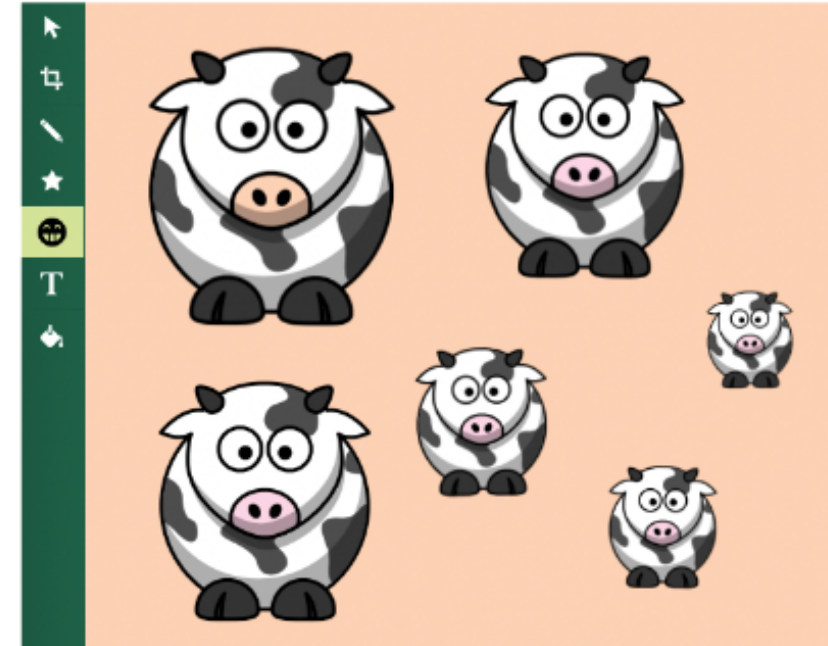


4. **Click** the left mouse button and **drag** the image onto your background.

Adding Clipart stamps

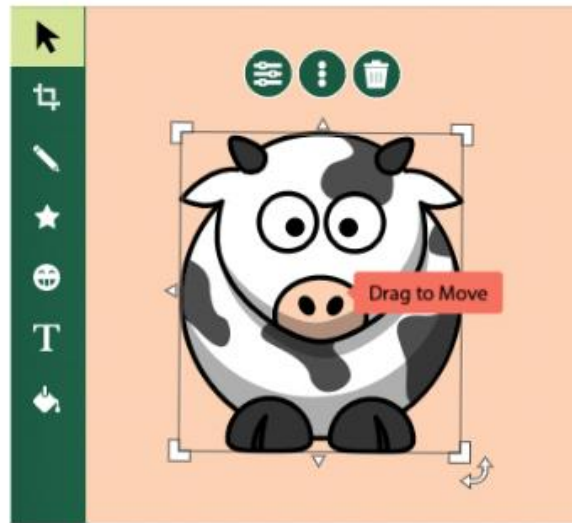


5. **Rotate** or **change the size** of the stamp by moving the mouse sideways as you drag it.



6. **Click** elsewhere on the background to add more of the same image.

Create your repeated pattern



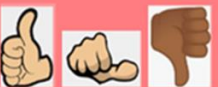
Use the **select arrow** to move, stretch, size or rotate your images.
