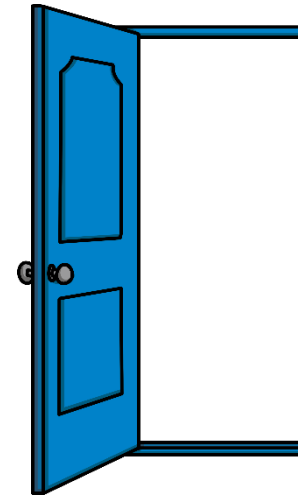
This is another **conjunction**: The conjunction '**because**' is used in the middle of a sentence to join two phrases or ideas together. We use '**because**' to explain our reason.



We played a board game **because** it was a rainy day.



Monika doesn't drink milk **because** she is allergic to it.



I opened the door **because** someone had been knocking.

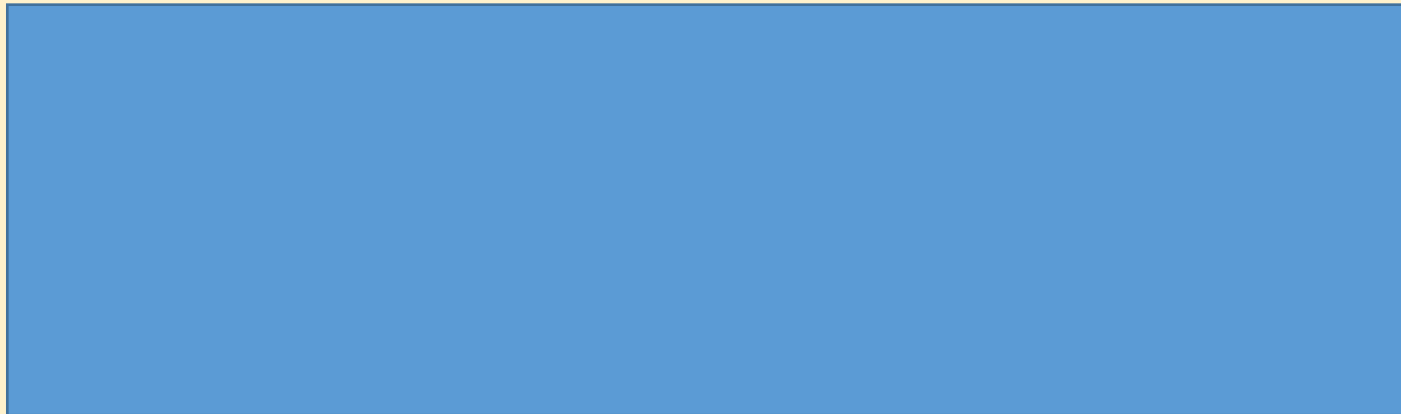

What is a suffix?

A **suffix** is a word ending that is added to the **end** of a root word. It changes the word and makes it **plural** (more than one).

What is a plural?

Plural means 'more than one'.

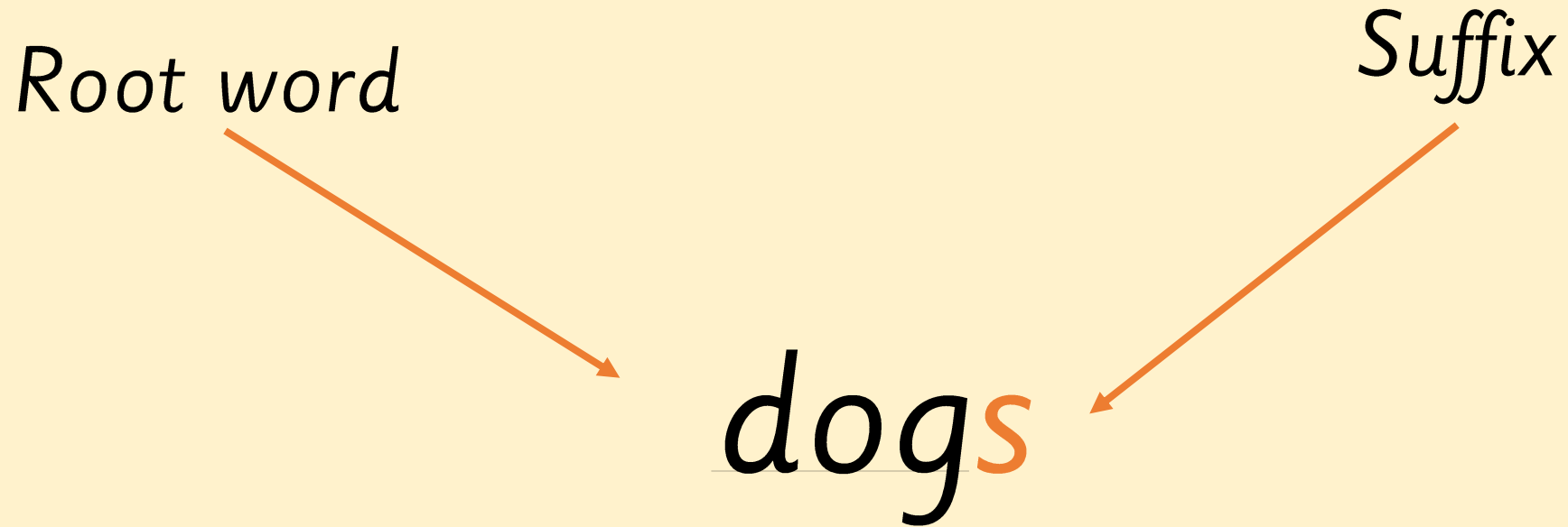
