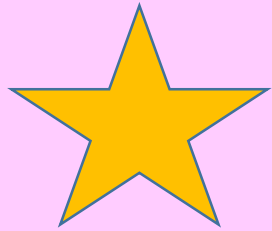
LQ: Can I create a piece of art work?

All – I can create a portrait.

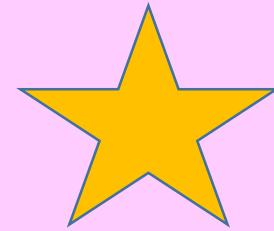

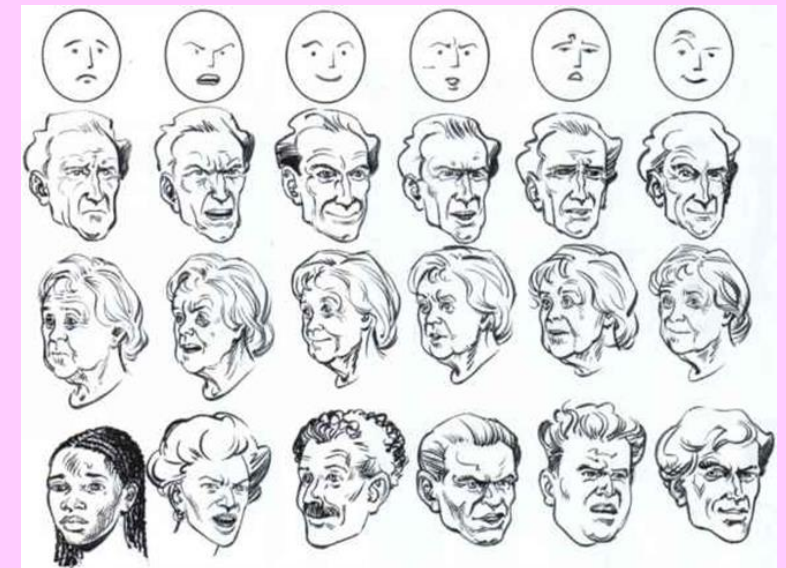


This week we will be creating our own portraits of someone influential. It could be someone famous, someone in your family or that you know.
