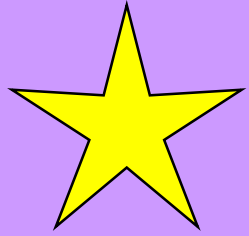

TP: What do you know about animals?

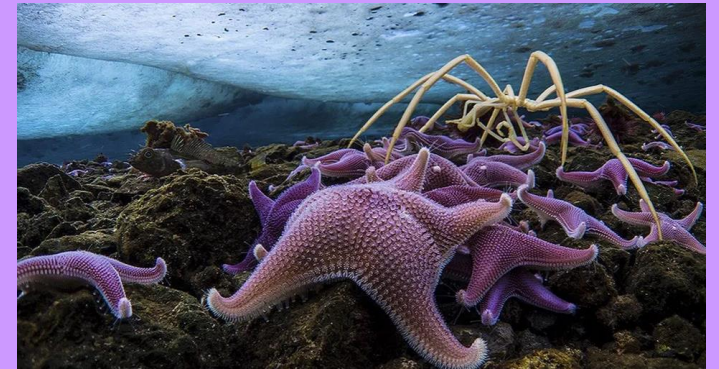
Miss Dhaliwal wants to buy a pet but she doesn't know which animal to buy or how to look after it.
