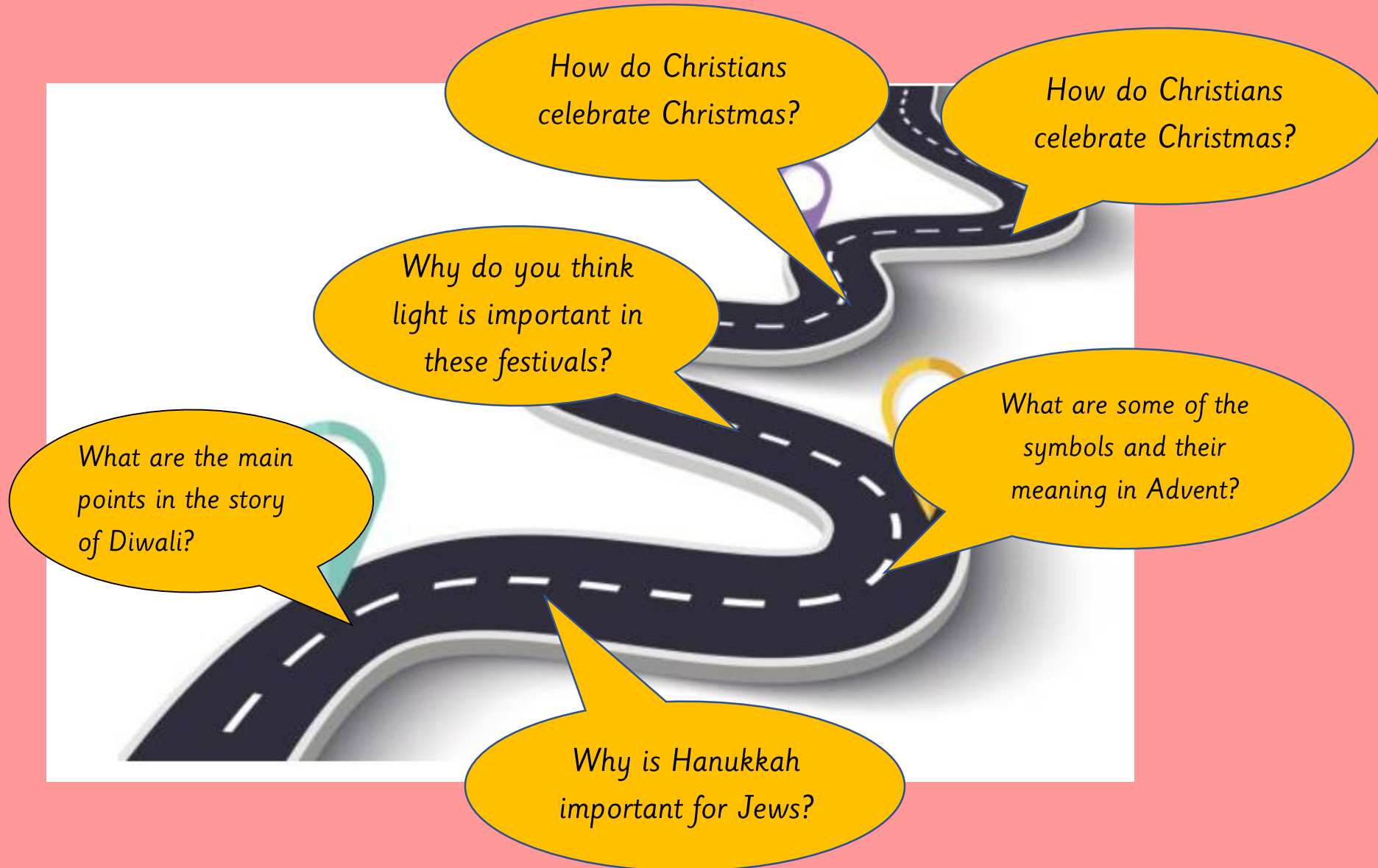

When the 5 minutes are up you will share your opinion with the class.

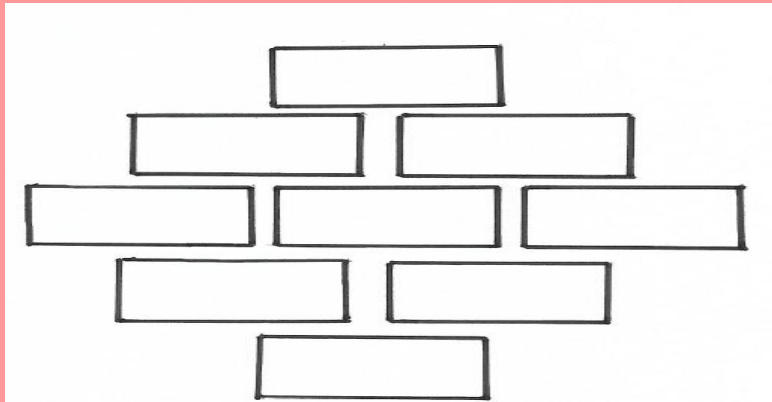


