Today we are going to listen to the story of Moses' early life.

Many years before, the Hebrew people had been welcomed into Egypt after a terrible famine. Over the years they had big families and now there were hundreds of them.

Moses was born at a time when the Egyptian ruler – The Pharaoh was treating the Hebrew people as slaves.



TP: How do you feel when someone doesn't like you and treats you unfairly?

Moses mother and sister tried to protect him by putting him in the basket in the river.

His sister followed the basket as it floated through the river. She saw the Pharaoh's daughter take the basket out of the water and decided to look after him.

We treat them with respect.

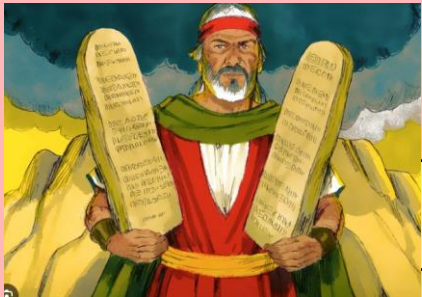
We listen to them.

We tell them how special they are to us. We acknowledge if we have hurt them and change our actions.

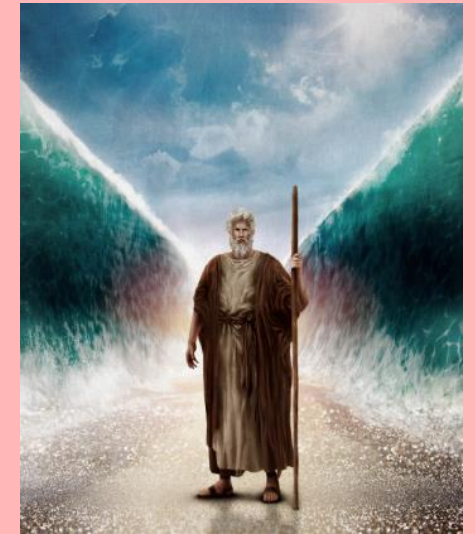
We make sure our words and actions don't hurt them.
