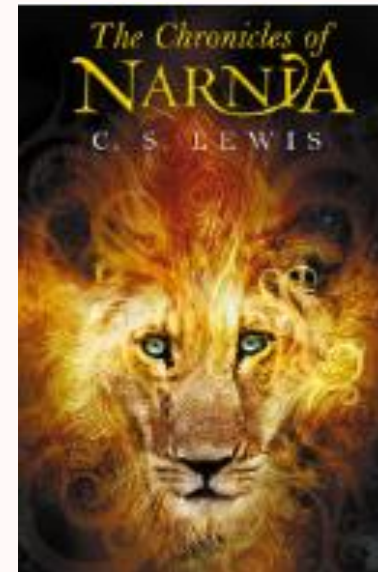
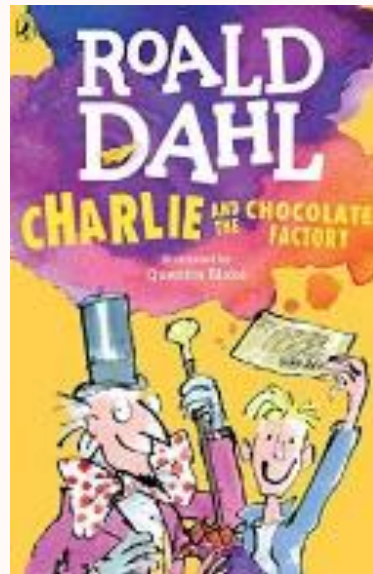
Instruction books

An instruction book tells you how to complete a task step by step.



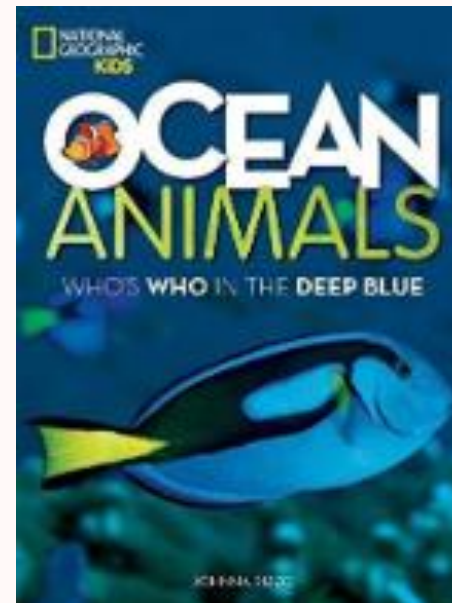
Fiction

A fiction book is a made up story. The characters and events that happen are not real.



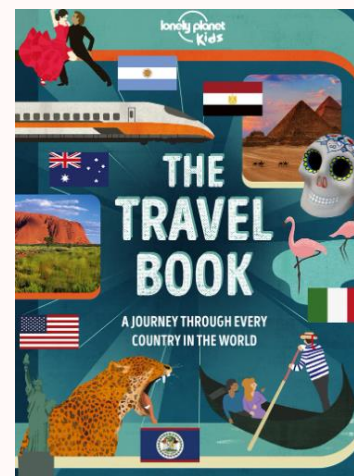
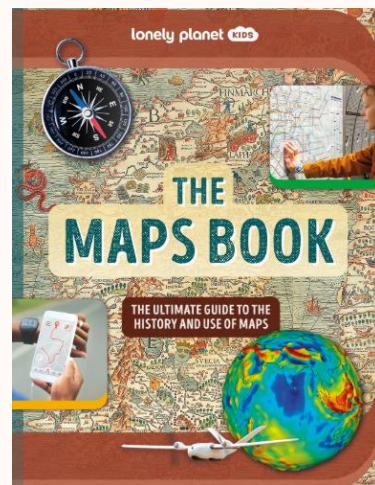
Information books

An information book gives you facts and true information about a specific subject.



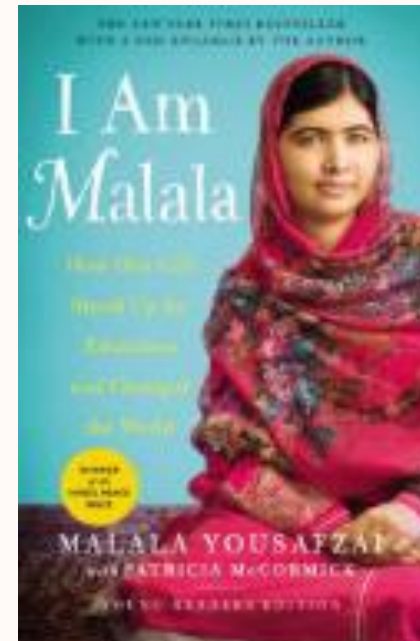
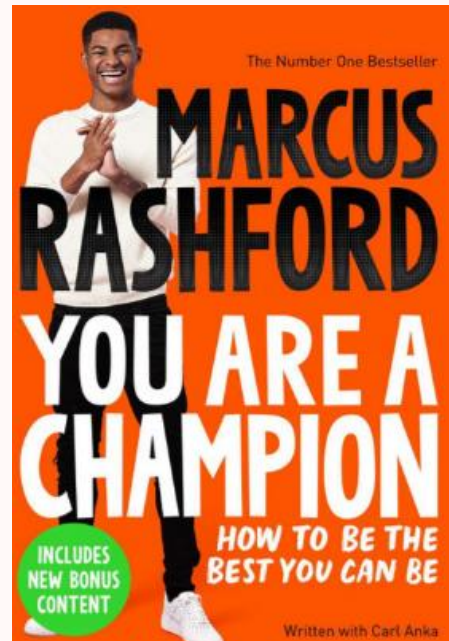
Guidebooks

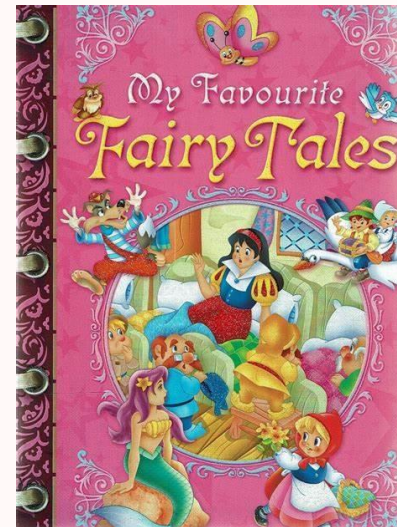
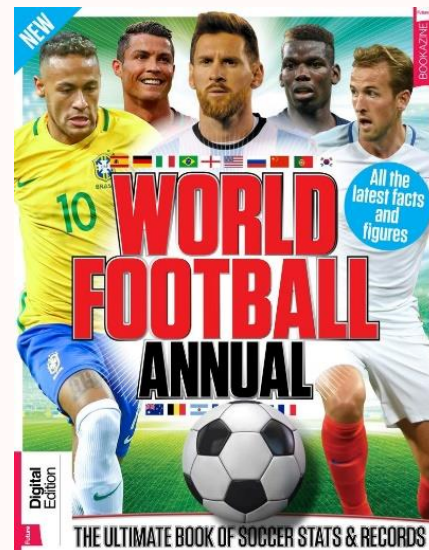
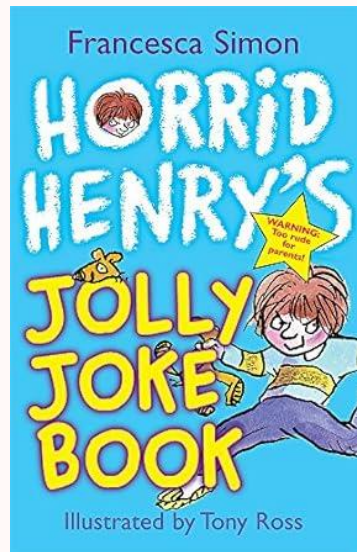
An autobiography is a book where a person writes about their own life. They tell real stories about themselves.
