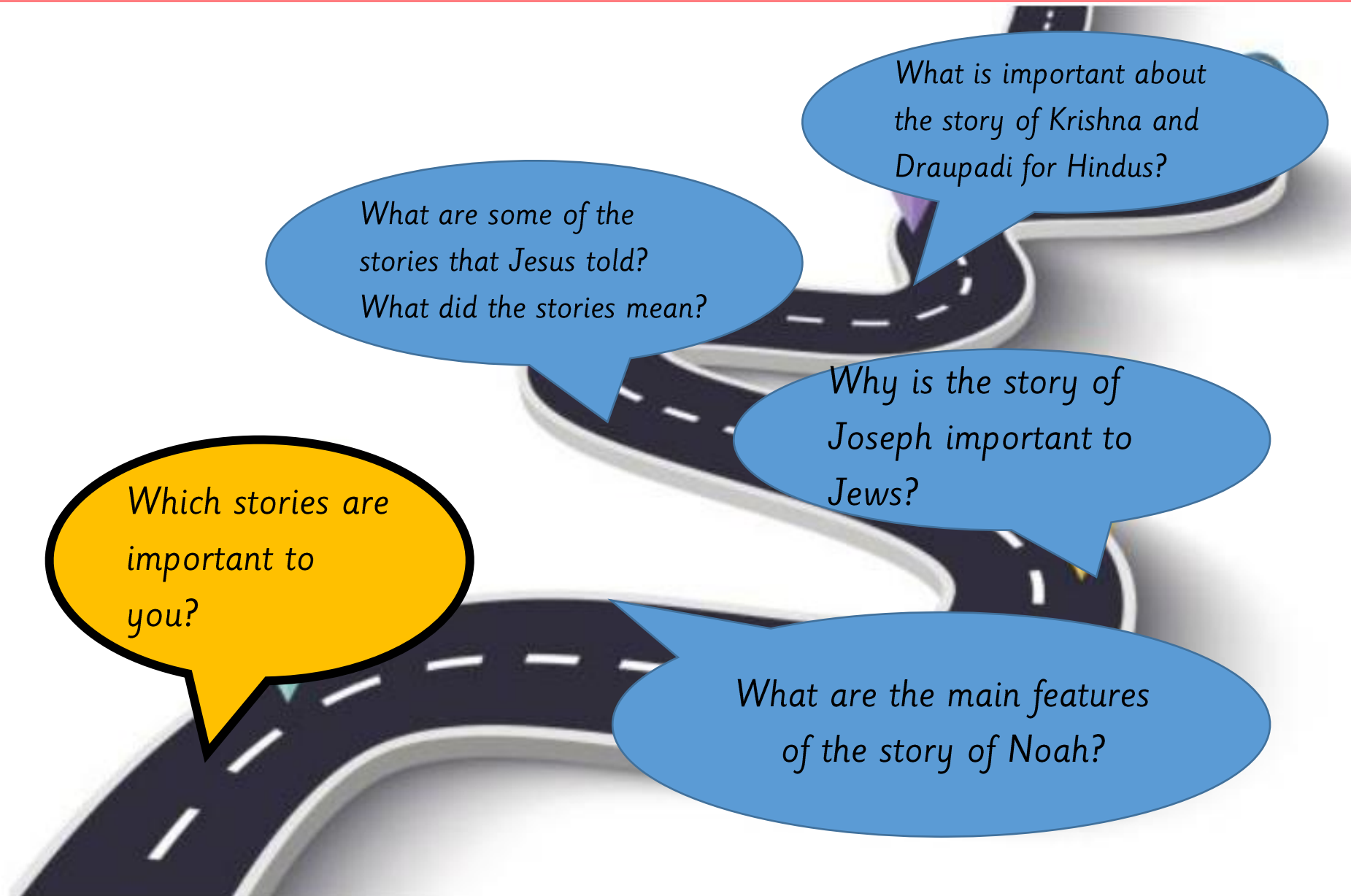

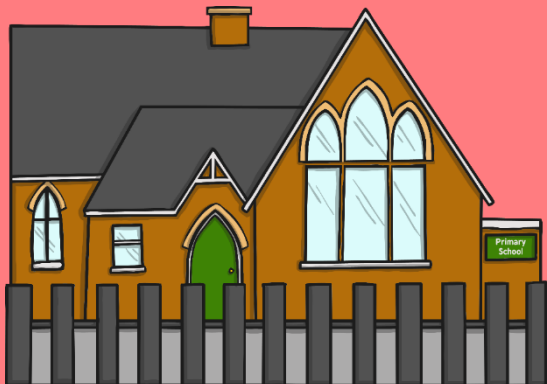


Monday 23rd February 2026

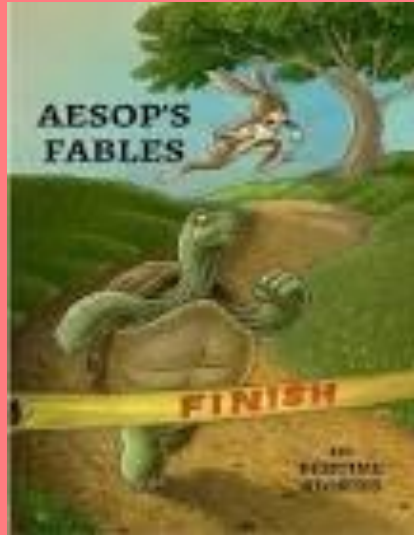

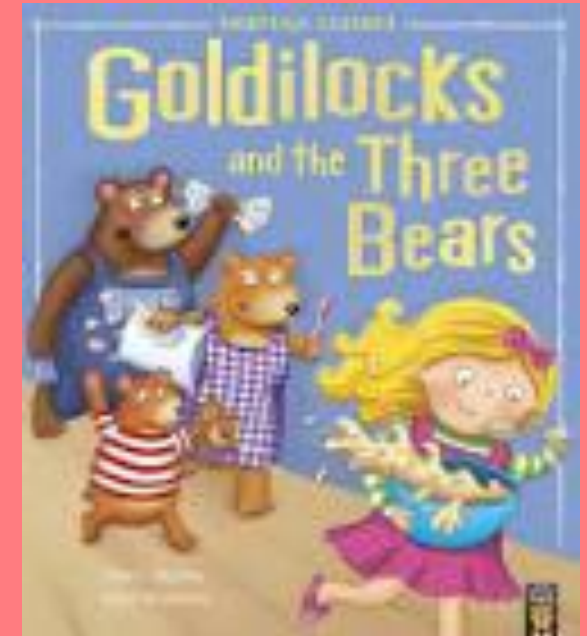

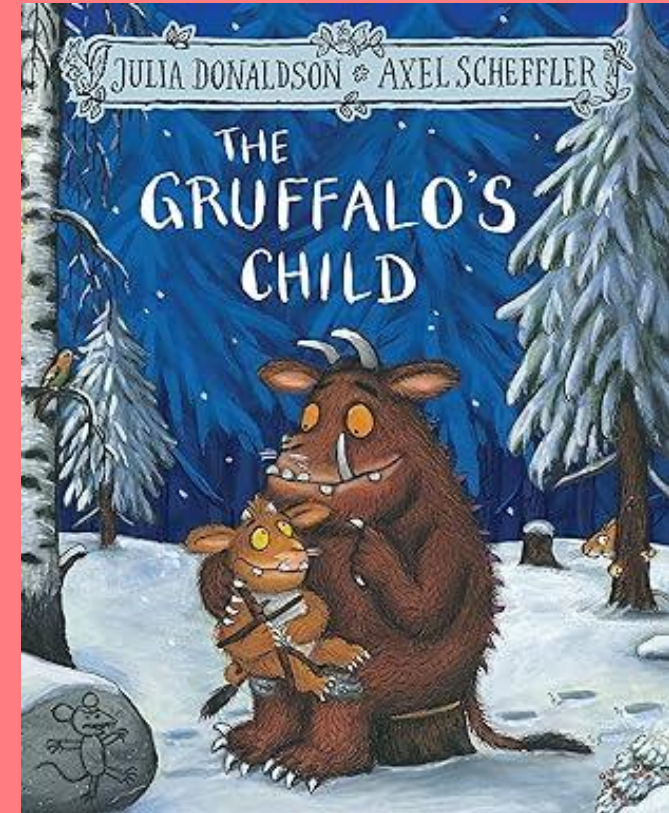
