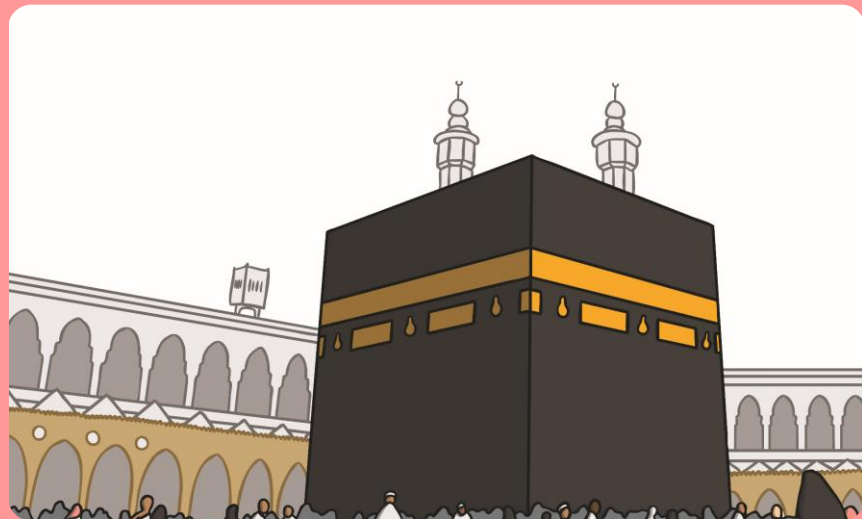

Today we are going to discuss how Muslims learn from the Prophet Muhammad.

Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) was born in Mecca, Saudi Arabia, around 570 years after the birth of Prophet Isa, 'Jesus' (peace be upon him).



Whenever we mention or hear Prophet Muhammad's name, we always follow with, "Peace be upon him."

Allah sent Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) as the last messenger to teach Islam to everyone.

Muslims do not have images of Allah or Prophet Muhammad.

Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) was a very honest and kind person.

Everyone loved him, even before he became a prophet people used to call him 'The honest, the faithful.'

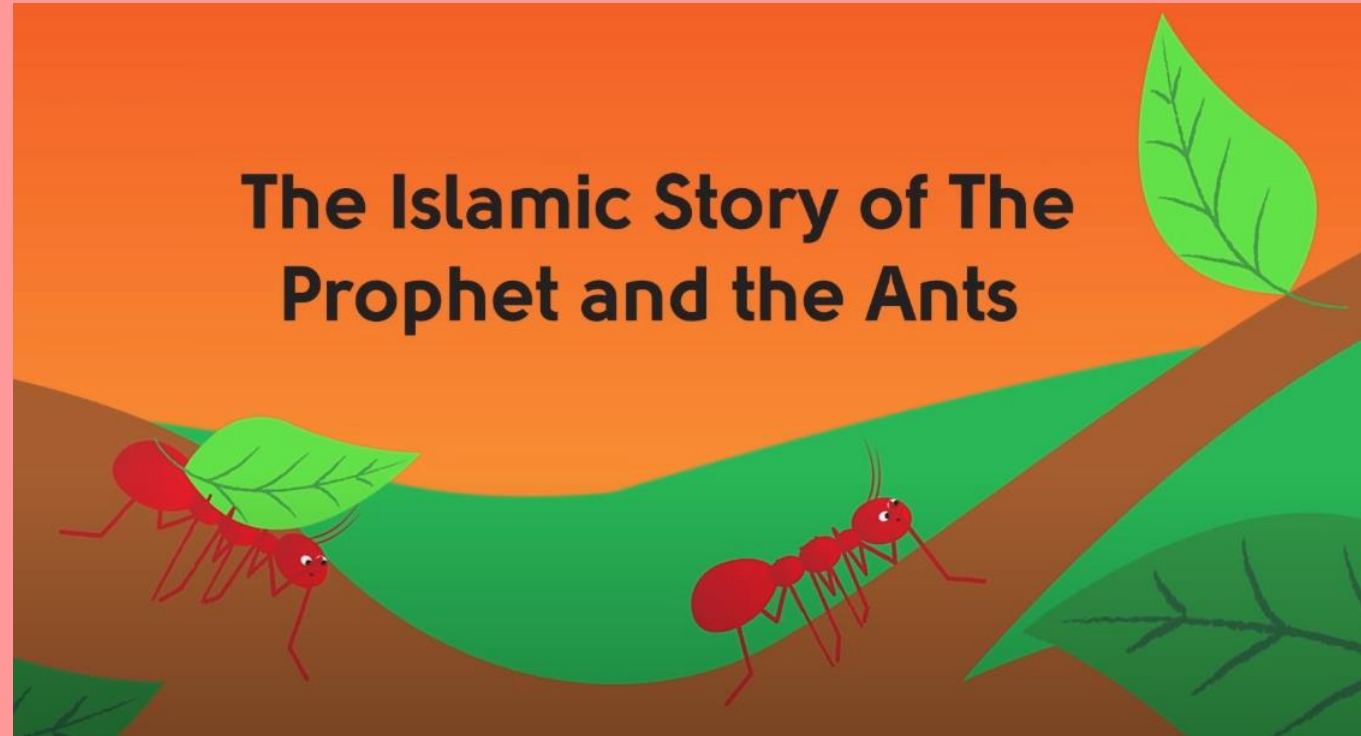


Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) taught people the Qur'an and that there is only one God, Allah, who created everything.

Muslims believe Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) was a good leader because he was honest, kind, respectful and faithful.

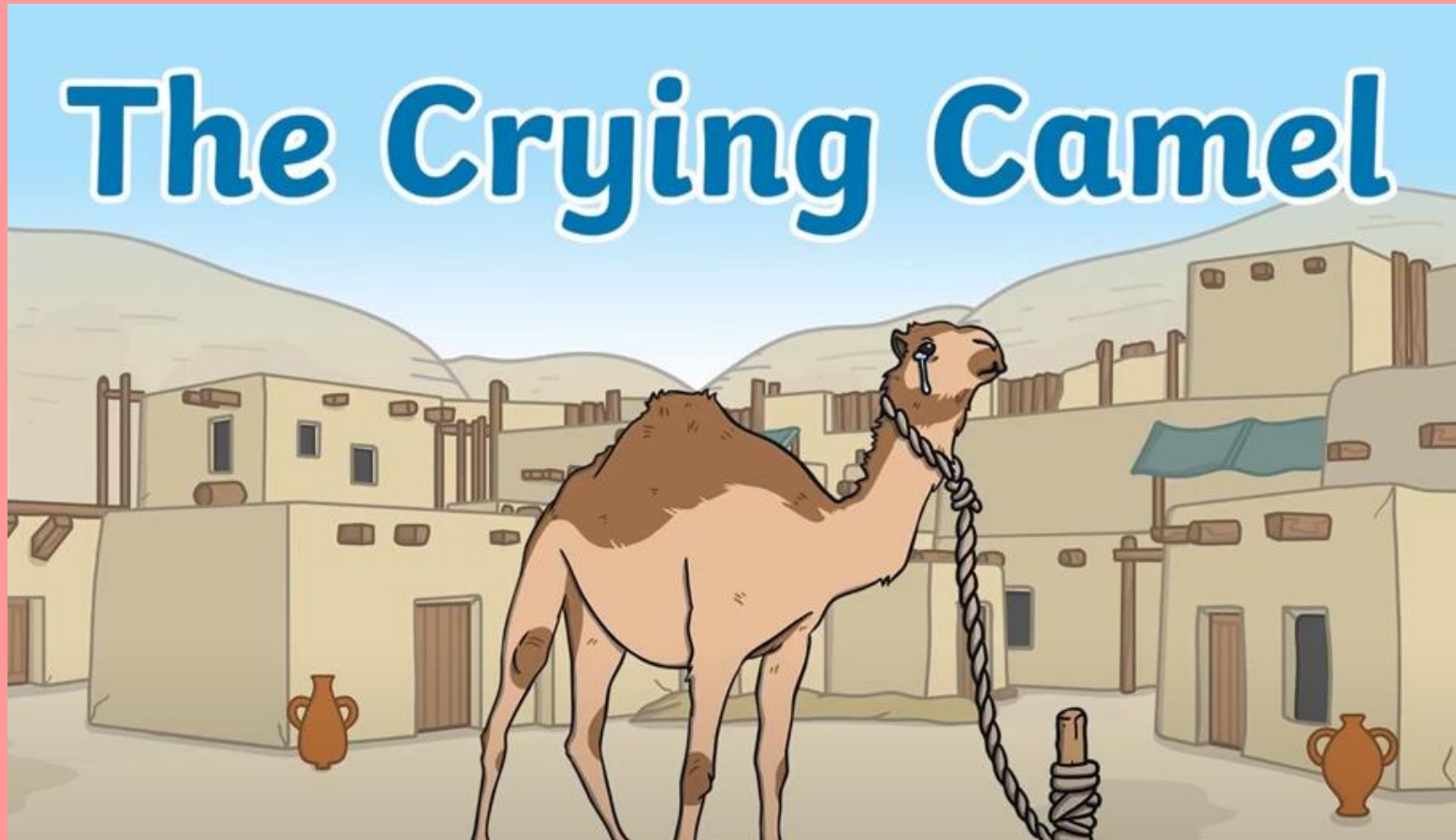
