There are many books that Hindus read. These include the Upanishads (oo-pan-i-shads), the Vedas (vay-das) and the Bhagavad Gita (bag-a-vad gee-ta). Not all Hindus read the same texts. They are written in an ancient language called Sanskrit.



# Krishna

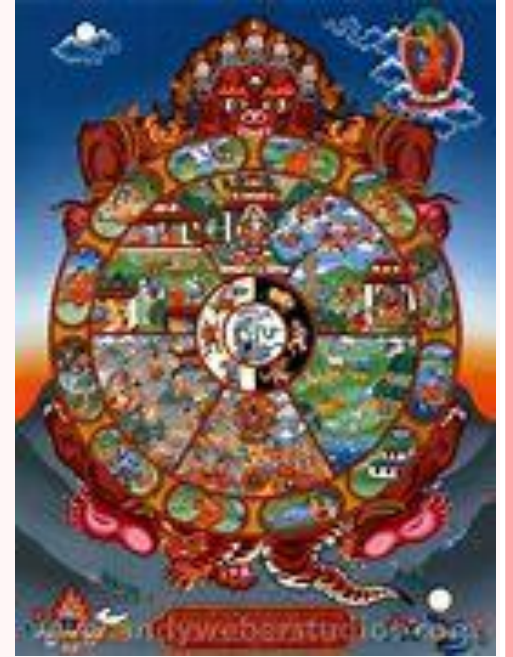

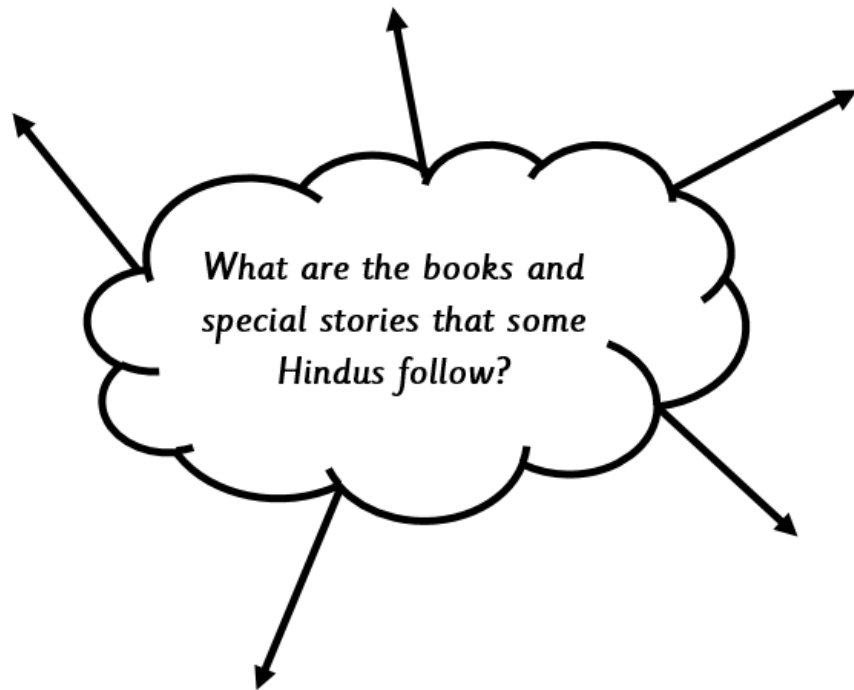
