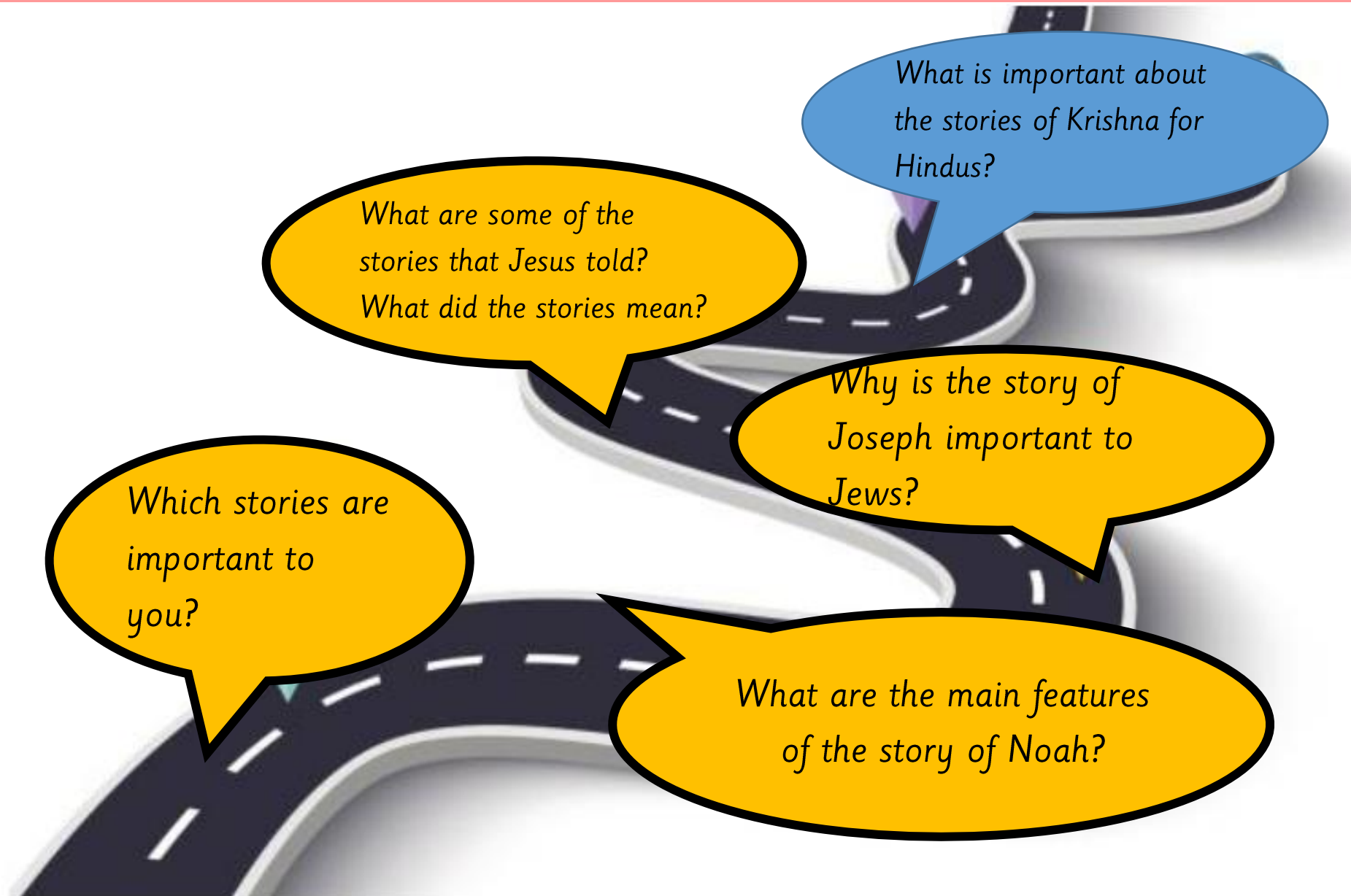

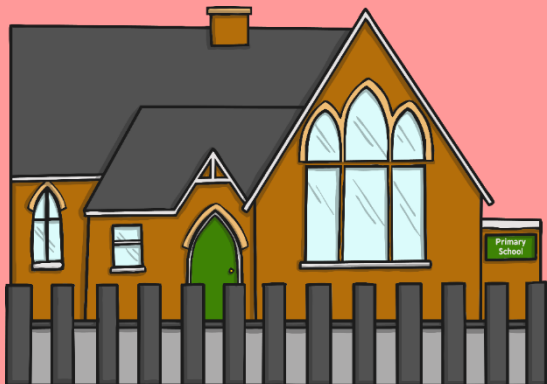


Monday 16th March 2026

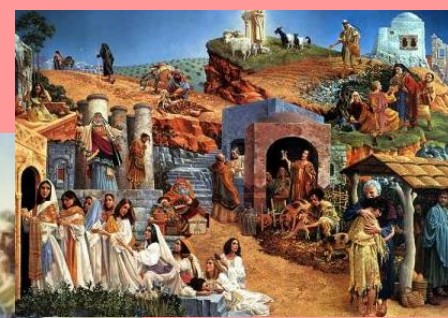

Jesus told parables

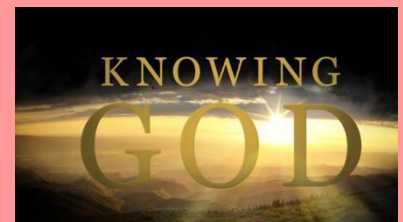


A parable is a story that has a meaning.

A parable is an simple story that tells Christians something about God.

Jesus told parables to help people understand how God wanted them to live.

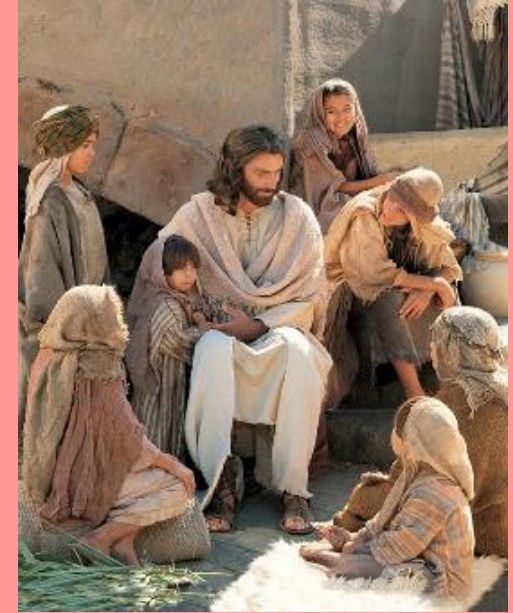

The meaning of the Lost Sheep

God loves and cares about everyone.

Jesus wanted people to understand that God is like the shepherd and they are like the sheep – sometimes they wander off, or make bad choices or get into danger. **However Jesus will always be there to welcome you back and watch over you.**

TPs: Why do you think Jesus told stories?

*Jesus was an amazing storyteller and these stories were linked to the everyday lives of his listeners. These stories (parables) were about **the Kingdom of God**; they showed Christians how to behave, how to treat others and what God is like.*

You are going to act out your own story based on the parable of the lost sheep.

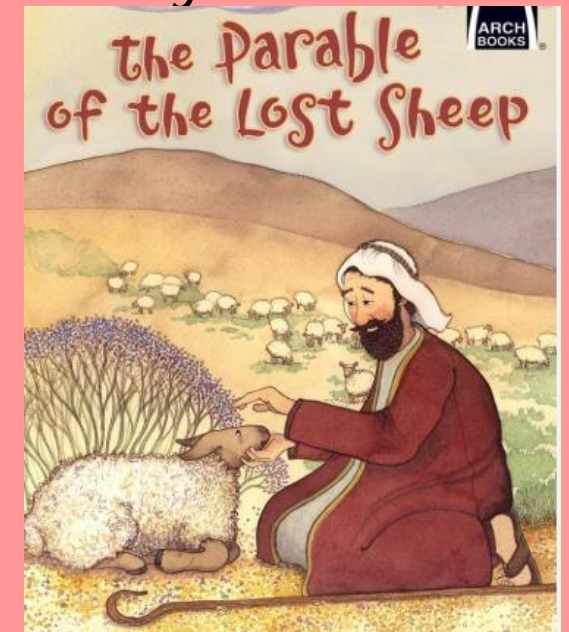
Get into pairs and choose an animal.

Jesus told the Parable of the Lost Sheep

2. Do you know why Jesus told parables?

Jesus told parables to teach people about God.

3. Can you describe how a story can have a message?

The Lost Sheep is a parable told by Jesus to remind people that God will always help them.
