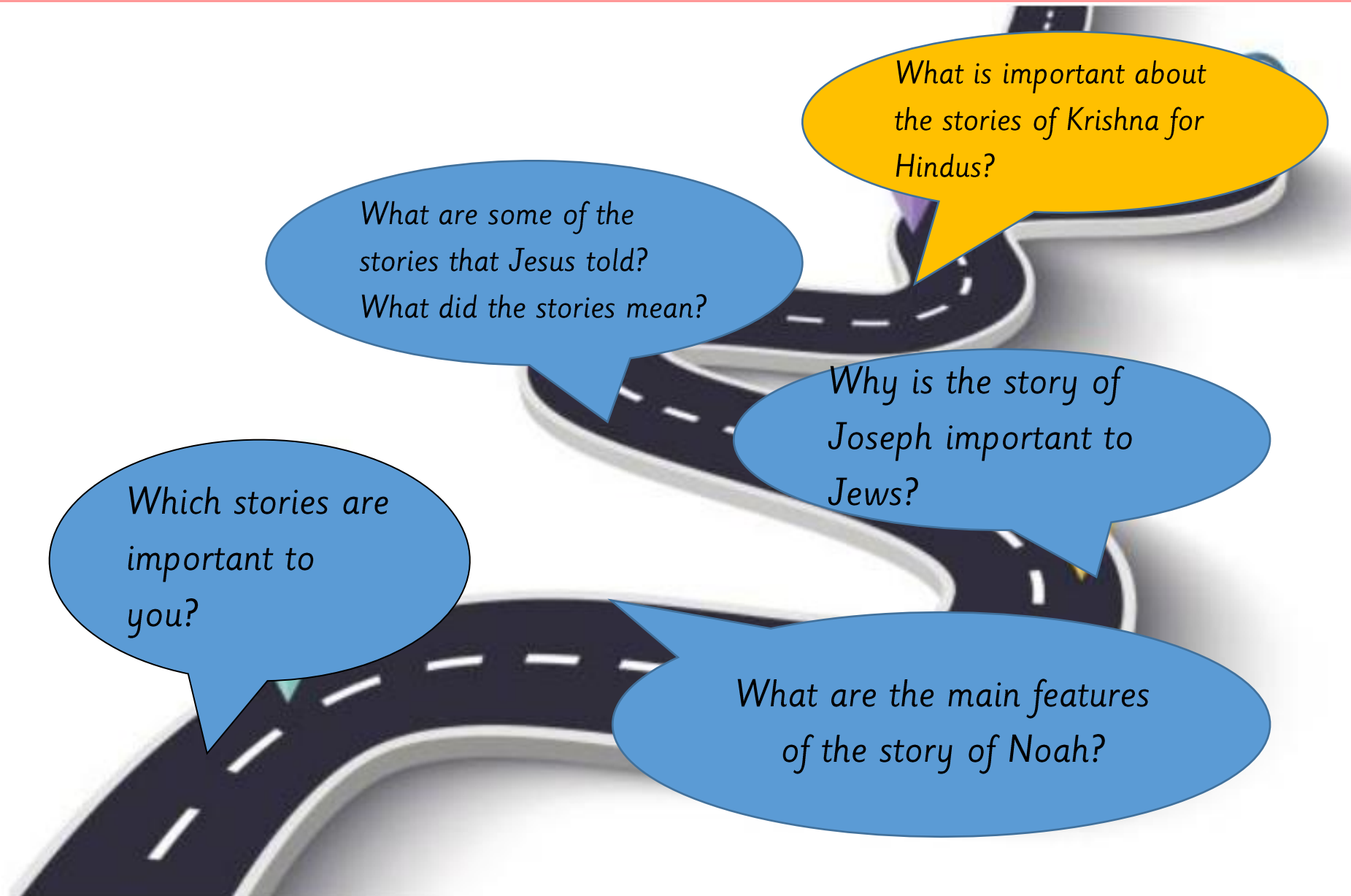

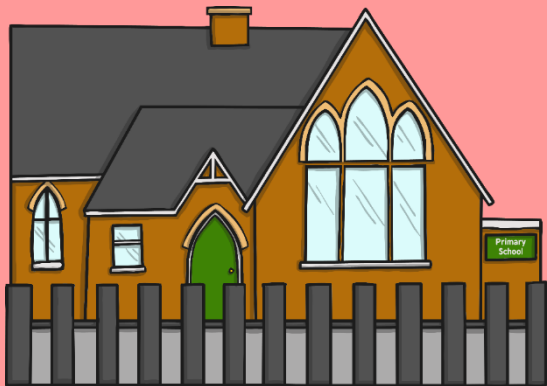

TP - What is the purpose of a parable?

The meaning of the Lost Sheep

God loves and cares about everyone.

Jesus wanted people to understand that God is like the shepherd and they are like the sheep – sometimes they wander off, or make bad choices or get into danger.

- Stories about him help Hindus to learn about making good moral choices.

- *Indra was the God of thunder and rain. But he was blinded by his powers.*
- *All the villagers came to Krishna for rescue.*
- *Krishna played his flute to comfort the worry of the villagers. This condition continued for seven days and seven nights. After that Indra finally realised that he was wrong and came and apologised to Krishna.*
