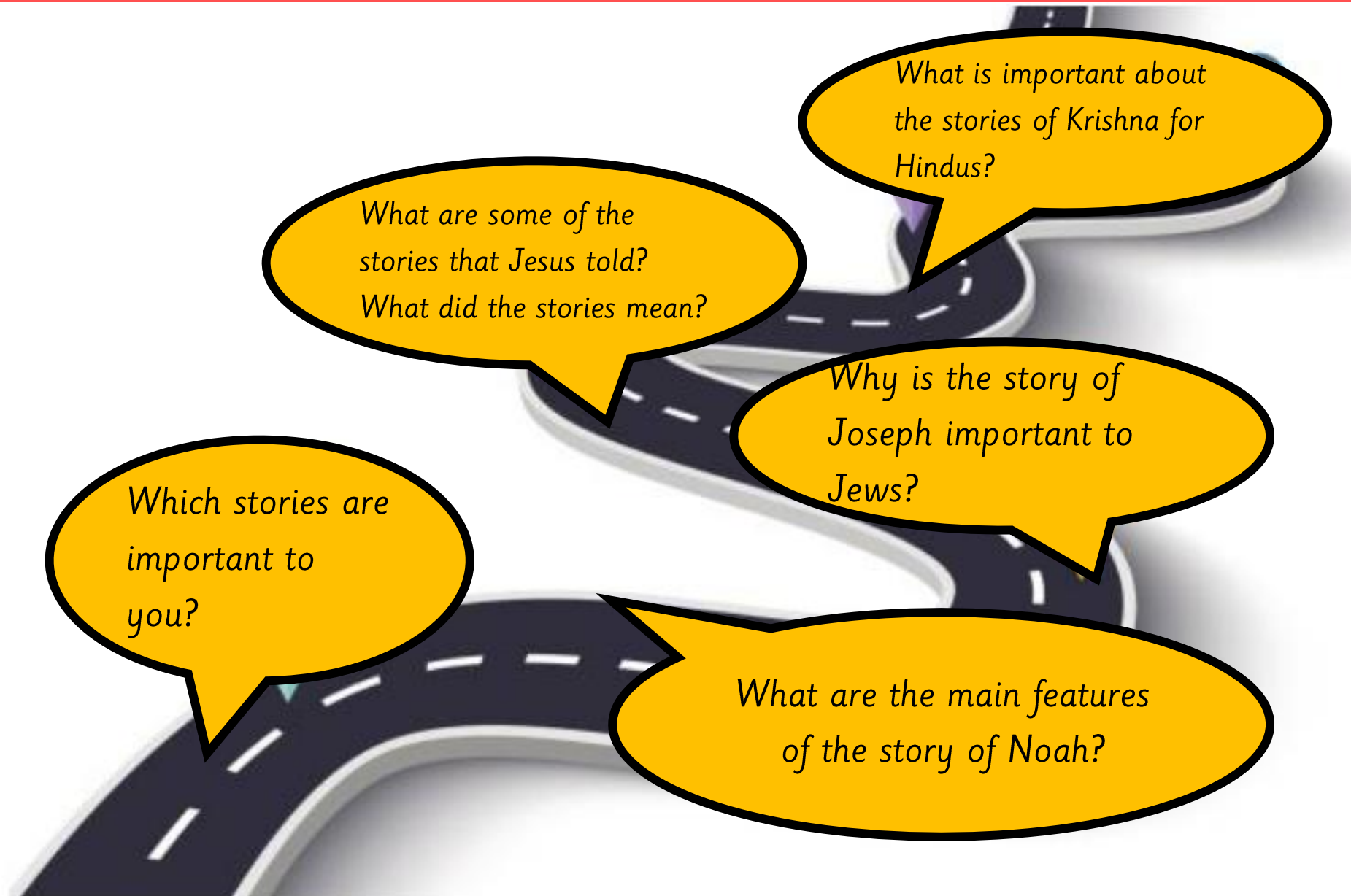

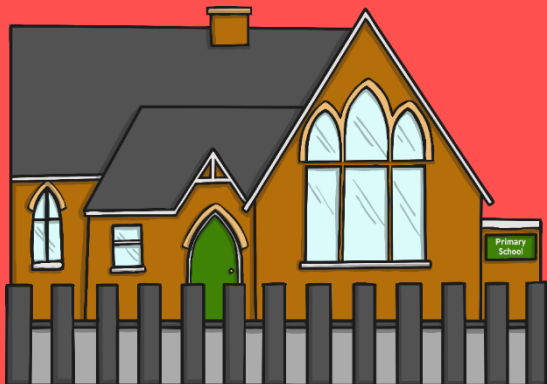

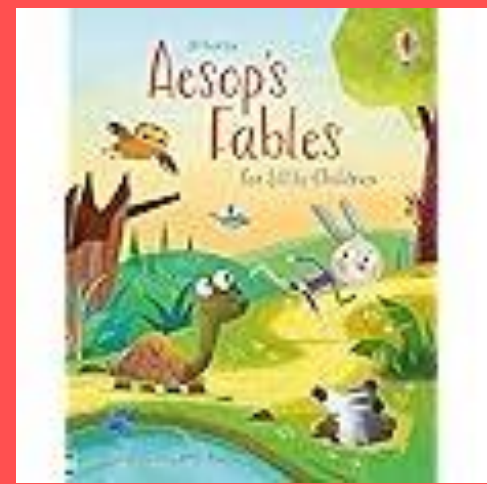

TP: can you recall which story reminds believers that God has a plan?

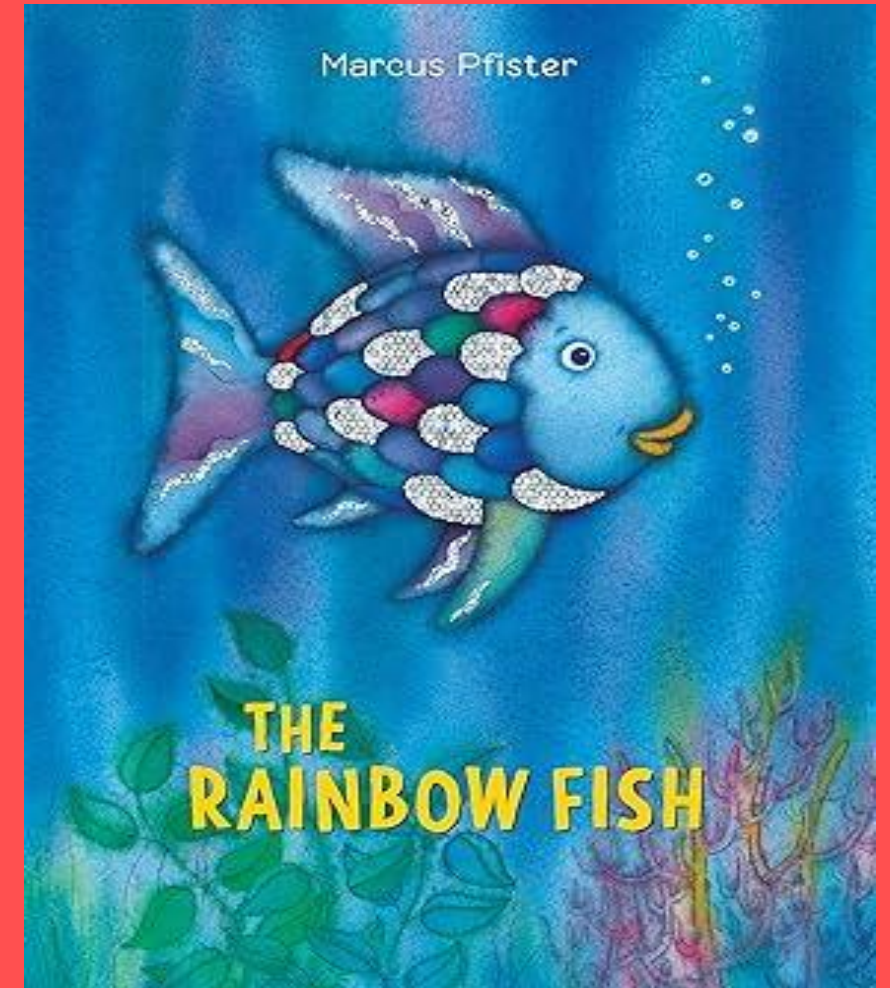
The Rainbow Fish
