Steps to Success

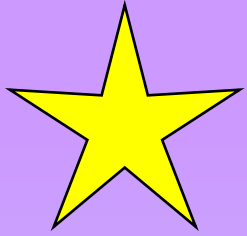


All: I can observe plants closely.
