We also celebrate our **STARS OF THE WEEK** on Fridays. Two children per class are chosen for certificates and praised for their efforts in their learning and development. Session times:

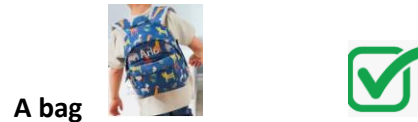

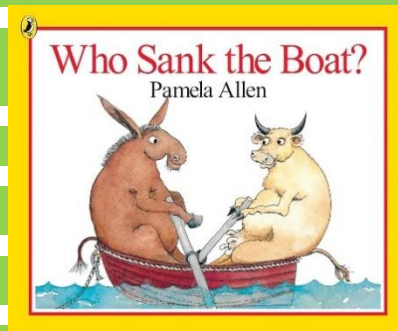
