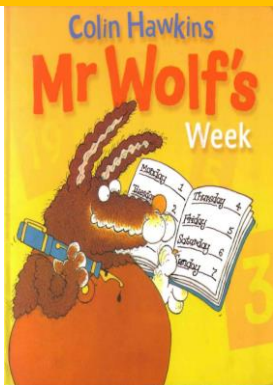
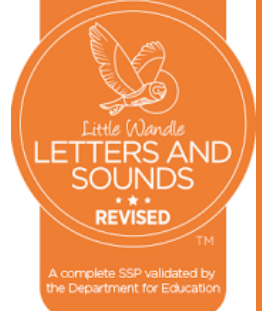
Phonics

Next week we will be revisiting some of the maths skills we have learned this year such as counting in 2s, repeating patterns, measuring and 2D shapes.

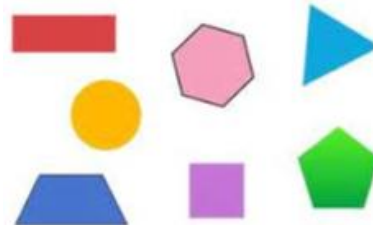
- What comes next?
