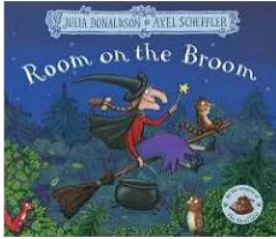

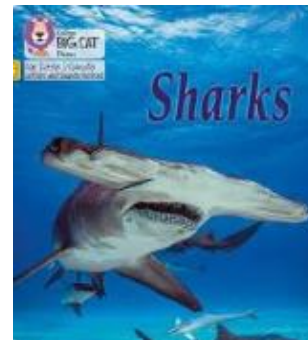
Reading Books & Reading Records
