On the top put jam so sweet

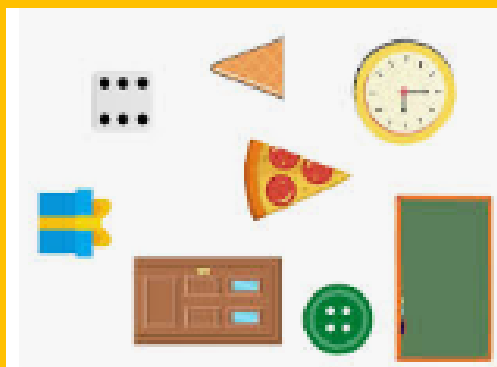
And now it's good enough to eat

We recapped about numbers and counting.

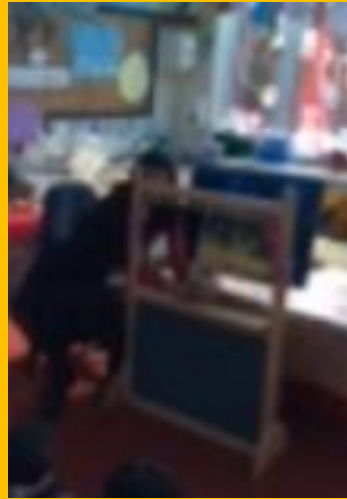
We spoke about different shapes using informal and Mathematical language
